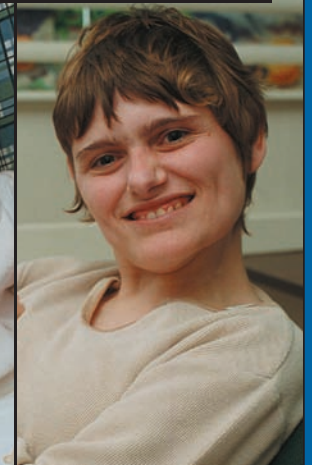

HeartShare serves more than 20,000 individuals and families each year throughout Brooklyn, Queens and Staten Island.

Our History HeartShare opened its doors in 1914 to assist young adults transitioning from orphanages to life on their own. As orphanages began closing in the 1960s, we adapted our services and started offering foster care. In the 1970s, we began assisting people with developmental disabilities, and in the 1990s, we opened programs for people with HIV/AIDS. Today, HeartShare offers a complete spectrum of services, from early childhood through adulthood.

Eligibility Eligibility requirements vary from program to program.

Cost to You Nearly all of our programs and services are provided at no cost. No one is turned away due to an inability to pay.

Our Programs

CHILDREN AND FAMILIES SERVICES

Foster Care and Adoption HeartShare cares for hundreds of children in need each year, working to reunite them with their natural families or place them with loving adoptive parents.

Independent Living Young adults leaving foster care are provided support as they transition to life on their own.

Family Service Centers Our network of community-based centers provide counseling and assistance with vital services.

Youth Programs Our after-school and summer camp programs provide a safe and fun haven for hundreds of children.

HIV/AIDS Services We provide case management and housing to people with HIV/AIDS.

Energy Assistance Programs In partnership with NationalGrid, Con Edison and Entergy, we assist low income individuals and families with their utility bills.

DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES

Residential Programs HeartShare offers adults a range of residential alternatives with appropriate supports and supervision.

Day Programs HeartShare helps adults reach their fullest potential through skills training and volunteer and work experiences.

Early Education Services Children from from age 3 through 5 with developmental delays or disabilities get a strong start in life at HeartShare. We offer evaluation services, Preschool programs, and Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK).

School Age Program The HeartShare School educates children 5 to 14 with autism spectrum disorders and mental retardation.

Family Support Services HeartShare provides families caring for a loved one at home respite/recreation services, parent training, case management, modest grants for needed resources, and Fragile X information.

Medicaid Service Coordination

HeartShare's service coordinators support individuals and their families in gaining access to needed services and entitlements.

HeartShare Wellness HeartShare offers one-stop shopping for medical, rehabilitative and mental health needs.
