Blues for Autism Concert to Benefit The HeartShare School

(Brooklyn, NY)— Come one come all to the Blues for Autism Concert benefiting The HeartShare School, a program for children ages 5 to 14 with autism spectrum disorders. On Saturday, April 25, The Brooklyn Blues Band will perform at Peggy O’Neills, located at 1904 Surf Avenue in Coney Island. Doors open at 7:30 pm and the show begins at 8:00 pm.

The HeartShare School is operated by HeartShare Human Services of New York and located in Bensonhurst. It provides educational services, computer-assisted learning and recreational activities to 48 children with autism five days a week. It also offers speech and language therapy and physical and occupational therapy to those who need it. Students learn science, math, language arts, world history, geography, visual arts, and music. Each classroom has two state-of-the art computers with learning software appropriate to each child’s academic level.
